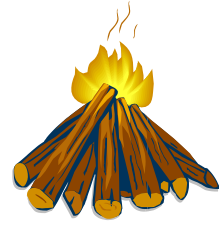


If you were going to build a treehouse, what would it look like?

What is the best meal you have ever eaten?



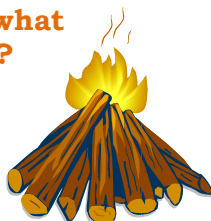
If you were going on a long trip, what three things or toys (besides your clothes) would you bring?
