

## Pre-Incident Plans

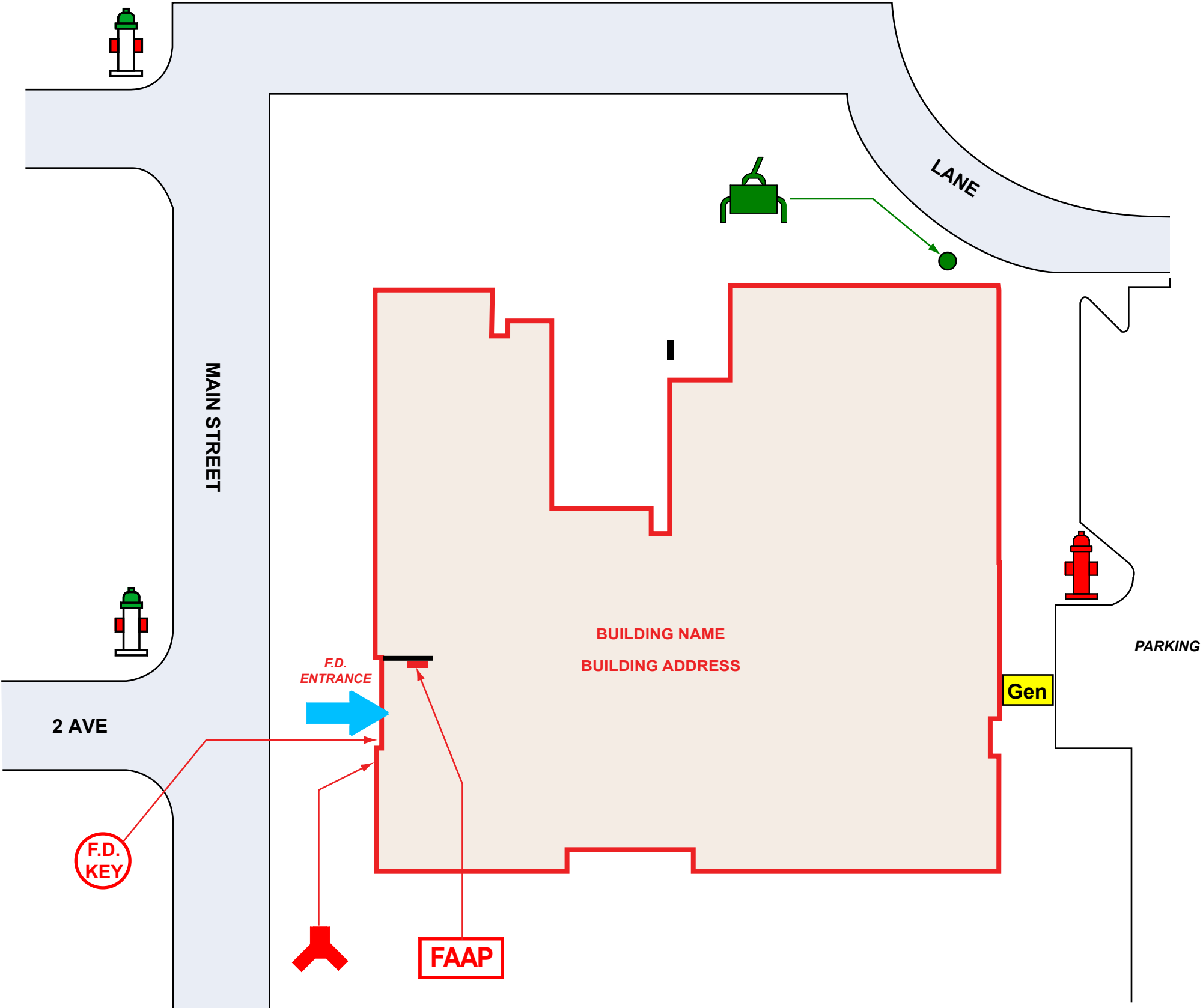
*Pre-Incident Plans are different than Fire Safety Plans and require the drawing format to be Fire Fighter specific. To ensure that your Pre-Incident Plan is properly formatted, please read the information detailed below and view the samples provided.*

The Pitt Meadows Fire & Rescue Service now requires Pre-Incident Plans (PIP) to be submitted with the Fire Safety Plan. The PIP is Fire Fighter specific and includes all life safety symbols, except fire extinguishers and pull stations. Pre-Incident Plans assist the Incident Commander in making quick, precise decisions based on vital information located on a well-designed Fire Safety Plan. Pre-Incident Plans aid responding personnel in effectively managing an emergency with available resources while fully understanding the hazards at the specific location.

***NFPA 1620: Recommended Practice for Pre-Incident Planning*** is the National Fire Protection Association standard outlining the recommended practice for developing pre-incident plans. NFPA 1620 defines a pre-incident plan as a document developed by gathering general and detailed data (pre-incident plans) used by responding personnel to determine the resources and actions necessary to mitigate anticipated emergencies at specific facilities.

The samples below show the same site plan and the same floor plan, one with extinguishers and pull stations (Fire Safety Plan Drawing) and one without (Pre-Incident Plan Drawing).

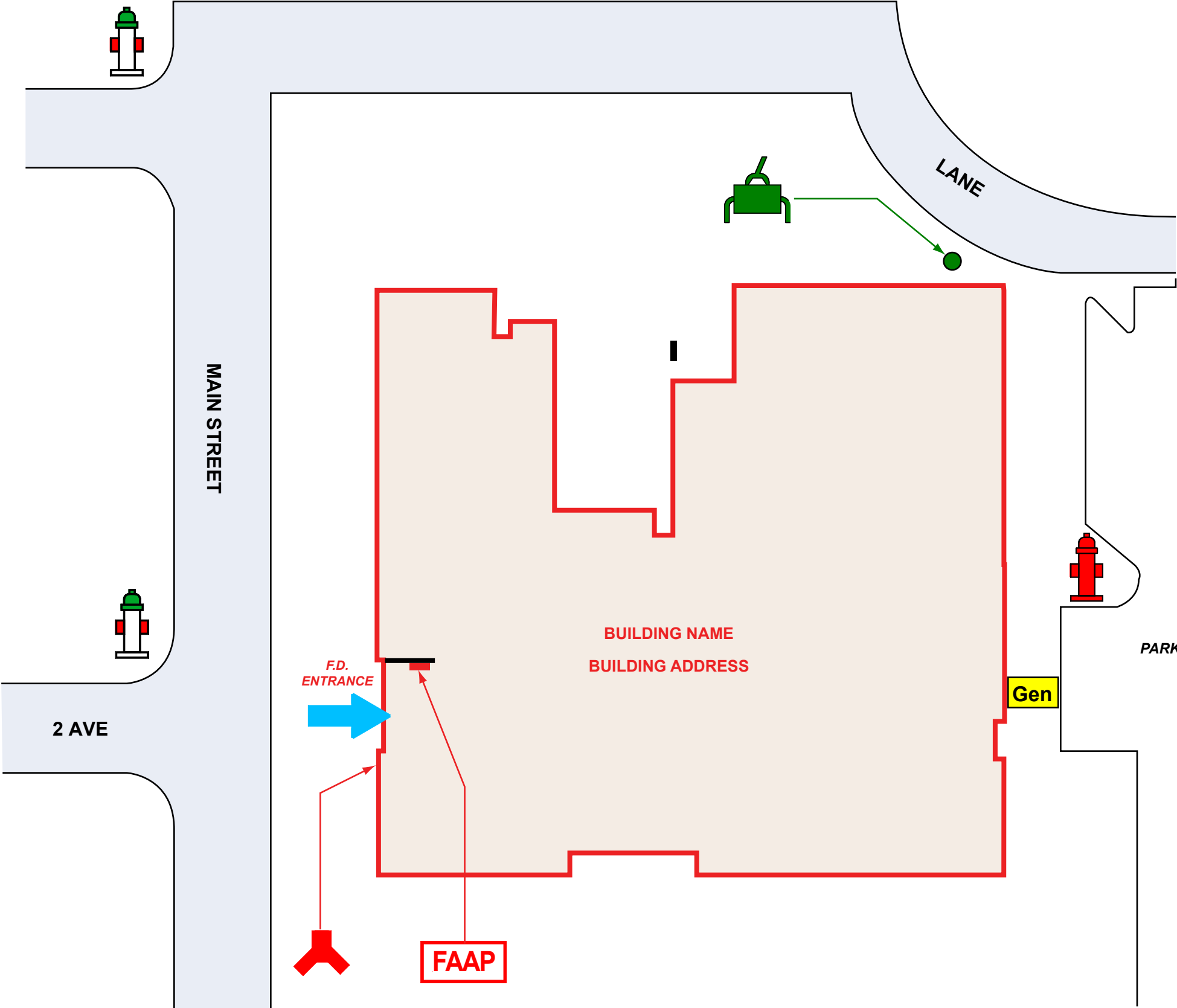



